Child and Adolescent Psychiatric Services

The Nord Center's Child and Adolescent Psychiatric Services include two board certified Child/Adolescent Psychiatrists and a Pediatric Nurse. Our Psychiatric team can provide psychiatric evaluations of children up to age 18, as well as medication management for a variety of disorders including behavioral and disruptive disorders.

The Nord Center Child and Adolescent department is a multidisciplinary provider of behavioral health services for children and teens and has provided psychiatry services as a component of its continuum of care since 2005.

Meet Our Team

Dr. Sunita Mathew, D.O., MPH, is a Board Certified Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist. She completed her Residency in Adult Psychiatry and Fellowship in Child and Adolescent Psychiatry at The Cleveland Clinic; and received her Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine from Lake Erie College of Osteopathic Medicine in Pennsylvania.

Dr. Mathew also holds a Masters of Public Health from The Medical College of Ohio and a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology and Sociology from Case Western Reserve University. She has practiced at The Nord Center since 2011 and is Board Certified in both Adult and Child and Adolescent Psychiatry.

Dr. Michael Hottois, M.D., is a Board Certified Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist with over 25 years in the field. Dr. Hottois received his Doctor of Medicine from The Medical College of Ohio and holds a Bachelor's Degree in Biological Science from The University of Chicago. He completed his Residency at University Hospitals in Cleveland; his Fellowship in Child Psychiatry at The University of Michigan; and a Fellowship in Forensic Psychiatry at The Center for Forensic Psychiatry in Ann Arbor, MI.

Board Certified in Adult, Child and Adolescent, Forensic, and Addiction Psychiatry, Dr. Hottois first began practicing at The Nord Center in 2005 and returned in 2016.
